Fancy trying JumpCross? Here's what you need to know

Whether you want to get the rush of going cross-country without the worry of having to jump solid fences, or perhaps you would like to use it as a training tool for a young horse, JumpCross is something you need to try.

What is JumpCross?

JumpCross combines the undulating terrain and natural elements you might find on a cross-country course with knock-down fences. It is an excellent way of training both horse and rider in the art of cross-country riding, and is suitable for all ages and abilities, yet commanding balance, skill and respect in order to jump them cleanly.

What are the MUNDOLE EQUESTRIAN JUMPCROSS/DERBY rules?

BHS Standard scull caps/hats and Body Protectors need to be worn. Baton whips only allowed. No spurs to be worn.

Penalties

> Knock-down 10 penalties for each knock-down.

> Refusal 20 penalties for each refusal (two refusals at the same fence and you will be asked to move on to the next fence).

> Six refusals around the course – Elimination

> Rider fall – Elimination

> Horse fall – Elimination

Courses will be approximately

1000m for Classes 1 and 2 and include approx 16 jumping obstacles

1500-2000m for Classes 3-6 and approx 20 jumping obstacles, all of similar colour, but of variable style and technicality.

Scoring

Course is timed and 30 seconds allowed each side of Optimum time without penalty. Seconds faster than the OPTIMUM TIME will incur 1 penalty for every second **over or under** the Optimum time. Penalties for knock-downs, refusals and time over or under will be added. The rider with the lowest score is the winner.

6. The organisers may in any dispute or any other matter act or decide in any manner they think fit.
7. Liability – Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of ME or anyone for who they are in law responsible, neither ME to which these rules apply or any agent, other employee or representative accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage. injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any person whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or any other way. Entries are only accepted on this understanding.
